The event is aimed at teachers at secondary schools who are interested in running a STEM programme for their own pupils to engage with local Primary learners in computing science activities.

What is the event about ?

This event will introduce you to “Micro:Bits on the Move — Young STEM Leaders”, a collaborative project between the University of Edinburgh’s Data Education in Schools team and George Watson’s College.

In this project, S6 students teach primary school learners about computing science concepts using Micro:Bits. Through this project, the secondary learners can gain a Young STEM Leader qualification (4 SCQF points at Level 6).

You will hear voices of people who have been involved in this project already, and find out how your school can get involved, and how this relates to the Young STEM Leader Programme.
